California Law Requires That:

All employers with 50 or more employees or independent contractors must provide at least two hours of sexual harassment and prevention of abusive conduct training to all California supervisors every two years.

New supervisors must receive prevention of sexual harassment and abusive conduct training within six months of assumption of a supervisory position.

Even if your company has fewer than 50 employees, employers must take “all reasonable measures” to prevent harassment and discrimination from occurring and regular supervisor training is one such measure.
